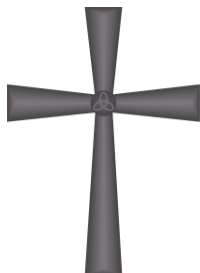

Spiritual Retreat *Encountering the Divine*

This day event will invite participants into a conversation from the Lutheran perspective on the nature of faith and life in the midst of challenge and even tragedy. Participants will also explore how the nature of hope and healing can be enriched through an encounter with the contemplative tradition of Christianity represented by the writings of Richard Rohr. Specifically, his book *Just This* will be explored.

- Encountering the divine in the everyday
- Personal stories of the spiritual, theological, emotional, and physical challenges of cancer and how being a Lutheran was and wasn't entirely helpful
